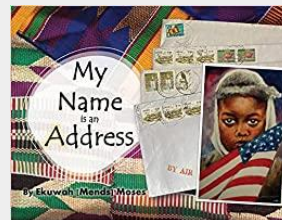
Ekuwah teaches us that names are an important part of your identity, family, and culture. What is YOUR name? Write it loud and proud! Does your name have a special meaning behind it?
